### Application Deadlines

The deadlines below reflect the last possible day to apply through [UNT GradCAS](#). Applying earlier is recommended to ensure a timely admission decision and, assuming admission, course registration prior to the start of the semester:

<b>3.0 Accounting GPA:</b>	<p>Maintain a 3.0 or higher Accounting GPA made up of these classes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Intermediate I &amp; II, Cost Acct, Acct Systems, Federal Income Tax I &amp; II, Advanced &amp; Not-For-Profit, Auditing, Research &amp; Data Analysis</li> </ul>

<b>GMAT/GRE scores:</b> Required of all applicants unless waived based on GPA  You may self-report scores, but <u>official</u> scores must be submitted directly to UNT (GRE code is 6481, no code for GMAT) Scores may not be more than (5) years old. Recommended scores: GMAT 520-570 or GRE 153 verbal/154 quant.	<p>GMAT/GRE Waiver Policy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Testing is waived for applicants who have earned a doctoral or professional doctoral degree from a regionally accredited institution.</li> <li>Testing is waived for applicants with a Master's degree and a 3.0 GPA from a regionally accredited institution.</li> <li>Testing is waived for applicants with a Bachelor's degree and a 3.0 GPA (either cumulatively or last-60-hour) from a regionally accredited institution</li> </ul>
