### Application Deadlines

The deadlines below reflect the last possible day to apply through [UNT GradCAS](#). Applying earlier is recommended to ensure a timely admission decision and, assuming admission, course registration prior to the start of the semester:

\*If seeking an F1 Visa and do not yet reside in the U.S., you should apply a minimum of two months PRIOR to the dates listed to allow time for issuance of an I20

Failure to list full academic history will delay processing. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Request all U.S. transcripts via CAS</li> <li>Upload official copies of all International Transcripts/Degree Certificates (official copies from your institution will be required if admitted)</li> <li>UNT students or alumni do not need to request/upload unless they have attended any schools since leaving UNT but must still list full educational history (transferring institutions and UNT)</li> </ul>	
<b>Essay of 600-700 words:</b>	Original narrative about your goals and what distinguishes you as a strong candidate for this program (applicants to MBA Music Business should submit 300-400 words & include portfolio links)	
<b>Resume/CV:</b>	A standard resume detailing work and academic experience is required for applications	
<b>Three (3) Recommendations from Professional and/or Academic references if required for your desired program*:</b>  <small>*OPTIONAL for ITSD (BUAN/IST) but may strengthen application. NOT REQUIRED for Accounting.</small>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Inform your recommenders about the process and that they will be completing the recommendation electronically. References cannot be family, friends, clergy.</li> <li>Request their preferred email address and ask that they monitor that inbox for your recommendation request (which will come from <a href="mailto:support@unt.myliasion.com">support@unt.myliasion.com</a>), including any junk or spam folders.</li> <li>Ask that- when prompted - they indicate that your letters be applicable to current and future applications, in case you need to update.</li> </ul>	
<b>GMAT/GRE scores:</b> Required of all applicants unless waived based on GPA (varies based on program)  <small>You may self-report scores, but <u>official</u> scores must be submitted directly to UNT (GRE code is 6481, no code for GMAT) Scores may not be more than (5) years old. Recommended scores: GMAT 520-570 or GRE 153 verbal/154 quant.</small>	Testing waived for applicants with a doctoral or professional doctoral degree from a regionally accredited institution. Applicants with a Bachelor's/Master's degree: Non-STEM programs - 3.0 GPA STEM programs* - 3.5 GPA  <small>*MS Business Analytics/MS Information Systems and Technology may receive a waiver with 3.0 GPA if degree earned is from AACSB (business degree) or ABET (engineering related degree) accredited school</small>
